# 5.6 Spending of Fund 5 (B&G) and Fund 3: Month of February

- \$15,892 was spent for Fund 3: CCBE books; SI culinary; 'Thank you' breakfast & catering for Academics, Steel Pan event & Jamaican Patties for Black History month
- \$9,576 was spent for Fund 5: new carpets with Galileo logo; mice prevention checks; new lights and caretaking supplies

#### 5.7 Galileo Adult Centre 2024-2025 school Calendar: 2 Ped Days

- For 2024-2025 school year, teachers will begin on Friday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, and classes will resume on the Monday, August 26<sup>th</sup>. Day classes will end on June 30<sup>th</sup>, and evening classes will end on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- Since both teachers and staff need the time to prepare for the new semesters, the ped days for the start of 2024-2025 will be held on Fridays: November 29<sup>th</sup> (end of Term 1), and March 21, 2025 (end of Term 2).

#### 5.8 Principal Report

- a) Update on Construction project P2107: Kitchen and Bathroom

  Construction work is still ongoing and on track to end in June despite some minor glitches in architecture. The next step is picking out appliances and selecting custom-made cupboards.
- b) Spring Session Registration began on March 25: Update March 25<sup>th</sup> marked the first day of classes for the new semester for CCBE Eng. & French, Francization and Academic classes. Registrants are walking in to register – the total count so far is 240 for day classes, and 225 for evening classes. Registration will be ongoing until classes are full or until the end of April.
- c) Recent Events at Galileo Update: St Paddy's, Podcast with Mark Bergman, Police Visit
  - St Paddy's: loonies for toonies fundraiser was held where students and staff donated loonies or toonies and in turn received a 3-leaf clover cookie.
     School raised \$500.00
  - For St. Joseph's, zeppole and Irish coffee were given to staff by Martina and Antoinette
  - Podcast with Mark Bergman from the Beat 92.5 (who also works with Inspirations newsletter) – Mark interviewed three SI Work Program students about the workplace they intern in – along with Miss Luciana. The three students spoke about their experiences both at Galileo and their internships and on how they've grown since they started. Martina will send the link to the Podcast to all GB members.
  - Police Visits: a community police officer held workshops for students on safety and security – two sessions were held so far, and another with SI students on March 26, and for Francization on identity theft and fraud in April

A fundraiser will be held in April, potentially called 'Buy your Socks off'
where students and parents can purchase socks online and 40% of sales go
back to Galileo

# d) Les Grands Ballets Canadiens at Galileo Adult Education Centre

- Starting Wednesday, March 27<sup>th</sup>, ballet sessions (offered free of charge) will resume until June 5<sup>th</sup>.
- DJ Jam (Djamboola) will resume from March 28<sup>th</sup> to May 2<sup>nd</sup> every Thursday where students paid \$5.00 and absolutely loved their experience last session
- Karate has restarted until May students will receive belts for this second session and the politicians who have donated money to this program will be invited in May to witness students receiving their belts

# e) New employee: Truly Moore

 Truly was hired on a new budget this year called rattrapage – she will help with student behaviors and implement intervention plans on Thursdays and Fridays
