



SVIS Program

The Socio-Vocational Integration Services (SVIS) program allows students to acquire the skills and support they require while transitioning from a school context to a job training and/or a part-time workplace. This transition can follow any of the path-way below, depending on the student's needs and abilities.

In-house Work Program

The student will develop and practice job skills within a classroom which simulates an employment setting through the completion of actual work contracts from companies.

Group Work Internship

With the support of school staff, the student will practice and apply job skills and behaviors that they have acquired through the in-house program within a community setting.
