# 1.11 Addition to the Galileo budget 2023-2024

- NTIC (technology) budget for Galileo is \$25,169
- Mesure 15021 MEQ Tutoring for Galileo is \$45,000. Resolution Adopted for Mesure 15021 of MEQ by the Centre's Governing Board
- The budget for this year is \$468, 885
- The expected spending is \$439,827
- Unanimously resolved to accept 2023-2024 budget additions for Galileo. Approved by Luisa and Gaetano

# 1.12 Financial 2023-2024 - B&G-Fund 5-refer to chart

- The budget for 2023-2024 is \$32,541
- This budget applies to snow removal, building maintenance and supplies for caretaking
- From this budget, \$448.39 was spent in August, \$737.03 in September and \$292.01 in October for caretaker's clothing and shoes. Refer to chart

#### 1.13 Financial 2023-2024 - Fund 3- refer to chart

- This budget applies to students: activities, services, books, field trips, supplies, workshops etc.
- August spending on school agenda for students
- September spending on CCBE and academic books, apple picking trip and bus, SI cooking program (food), Beaver Tail welcome back event, tote bags for students
- October spending on apple picking & bus on 2<sup>nd</sup> group of students, student dictionaries,
   SI cooking program (food), Karate Autism program for SI students, pizza kits for fundraiser, thanksgiving apple pies for students

# 1.14 Galileo Field Trips for 2023-2024

- 3 major school trips planned for this year: apple picking, cabane a sucre and maybe a trip in June
- Teachers are also permitted to organize class trips with admin approval depending on cost, date, and place
- Students choose to attend or not attend for they are adults.
- Student under 18 years old must get approval from their parent/guardian, they will sign the form

#### 1.15 Galileo Fundraisers

- Two fundraisers so far: Pizza Kits and Bowling
- Pizza kits: 144 kits sold; profit was \$1700
- Bowling fundraiser taking place on November 25<sup>th</sup>
- Due to the potential strike, not sure what is happening with the Bowling Fundraiser.

# 1.16 Principal Report

# a. Strike Update

- November 6<sup>th</sup> Strike # 1 until 10:30 am
- No disruption to students
- Most academics students came, no CCBE students
- Next potential strike: November 21, 22 & 23

### b. Galileo's new program Francization

- Free French classes offered (by the government MIFI) to anyone living in Quebec
- MIFI control the registration list for all schools
- Three classes to date have begun at Galileo:
  - o 8:30 am 12:30 pm; 1 pm 3 pm Monday to Friday
  - o 5 pm 9 pm (started October 30) Monday to Thursday
  - Rooms are full
  - More students = more funding

#### c. Update on Renovation Projects: Mesure P-2107

- 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Kitchen and 2<sup>nd</sup> floor south bathroom renovations to begin in February 2024
- EMSB in charge of the project

#### d. Galileo Tutors

- Three tutors have been hired: Daniele, Sofia and Laura
- Sofia and Laura are full time students, so their schedule is flexible
- They help CCBE and academic students, teachers with exams

#### e. Special Olympics Quebec at Galileo

- First Adult Centre in EMSB to have the Special Olympics program for our SI students
- McGill Nurses will teach health in October & November (4 Tuesdays lessons are on the brain, nutrition, skin, and the heart and lungs)
- Free services offered to students; free dental screening (just passed in October) and physiotherapy screening (March 2024)

# f. Autism Karate at Galileo—André Langevin

- André is back at Galileo on Fridays from 9-11 until the end of January
- Activity is funded by parliament members, therefore Karate is free
- Students payed \$20 for their shirts

# g. Les Grands Ballets Canadiens de Montréal--Angélique Dumet-Kerherno

- Every Wednesday until December 13th
- Contract is from September to December
- Dance/ballet show on December 13
- Not all students participate, only those who want to
- Hope to get government funding to continue in January 2024

# h. Staff Update

- Total: 75 staff members
- 7 support staff
- 4 caretakers
- 5 teachers (CCBE daytime) 7 teachers (CCBE evening)
- 5 academics
- 3 francization
- 5 community teachers
- 30 special needs (facilitators and teachers)
- 1 Academic advisor
- 1 educational consultant

- i. Update on Fall session August 28, 2023 to November 30, 2023
  - 300 students in fall
- j. Update on the Winter session December 4, 2023 to March 21, 2024
  - No students yet (registration in progress)
- k. Flex Space at Galileo Specialize tables and technology
  - Making class spaces more flexible (benches, couches, tables, etc.)
  - Make it feel more like a home environment
  - CCBE and academics first to receive specialized furniture
  - Ordered: 61 tables (\$20 000 total) 6–8-week delivery
  - New teacher desks (7 ordered), arrived this week
  - 17 new speakers for smartboards
  - These items will help teachers be more effective and will improve students learning.
- I. Update on Emergency Preparedness—Fire Drill, Lock Down
  - Lock down = intruder outside
  - Code silver = intruder inside
  - Fire drill = fire
  - Already practiced 1 fire drill this year
  - Lockdown and code silver will be practiced once every 2 months.
